It is with a sense of excitement that I am submitting our grant application request to the Wine & Food Society. As you know from our meetings, we are very pleased that the Wine & Food Society of Clark County is interested in partnering with the Culinary Arts Program at Clark College.

With Larry Mains at the helm, our Culinary Arts Program has one of the best reputations in the Northwest for its top-quality cooking program. The program has been at its present location since 1958 and has graduated hundreds of chefs, pastry chefs, cooks, bakers, and restaurant and bakery managers. Students train in all phases of culinary arts, from operating a gourmet restaurant to production cooking.

Among the many course offerings is our Wine Appreciation course. Students in this course, which is taught by Kaye Shattuck, learn three basic concepts: (1) the nature of wines, (2) the frame of reference, and (3) exposure to wines. As we discussed with you, this course is usually a supplement to a full course load of 15 credits.
